A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING BROOKFIELD LIBRARY'S
UNITED STANCE AGAINST RACISM

The Trustees of the Brookfield Public Library affirm the Library's commitment to inclusion and equity in response to the recent brutal injustices as well as to those that have preceded it.

We concur with the American Library Association's directive: "The Board therefore urges ALA members and member organizations, members of the wider LIS community, and library institutions everywhere to eradicate racism anywhere and everywhere it exists."


